When a player participates in the Women's Eastern Amateur or Senior Championship, her club supports the Association by remitting dues. Only clubs and schools can be members of WEGA, not individuals. Dues payments are the only source of revenue for WEGA. With this support the Association can provide players with quality, competitive venues and will allow WEGA to preserve the modest entry fee for each championship. The Women's Eastern Golf Association is a charitable organization under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. Dues payments are tax-deductible.
